PROJECT TRACKING

Successful tracking of 2021 Zonal Inspection Projects (ZIP) in the South West and South East geo-political zones of Nigeria. This is in line with the organisation's mandate to keep citizens in the loop on how well or not their representatives carry out their legislative functions. Hence the Zonal Intervention Projects were tracked across Imo, Anambra, Abia, Enugu, Ebonyi, Osun, Ondo, Lagos, Oyo, Ogun and Ekiti Federal Constituencies.



EVENTS

The 2022 season was filled all year round with high impact activities and events.

- We had 10 specially packaged Public Engagement Events on Fiscal Reforms, Extractive Transparency, and voter education and mobilisation
- The First-ever Town Hall on Legislative Elections for National Assembly candidates in the FCT with

Don't Borrow N4trn For Subsidy, Sell Part Of NNPC, Stakeholders Urge FG
 ...As crude swap drains N22.68trn forex in 18 months

The Federal Reserve Council (FRC) has given approval for the NNPC to enter into an agreement with ECOWAS for the construction of the Nigeria-Morocco Gas Pipeline.

Minister of State for Petroleum Resources, Stephen Okeja, briefed State House correspondents after FRC meeting presided over by Vice President Tinubu on Wednesday at the apex of the foreign exchange swap deal which will be determined by the pipeline's cost.

The pipeline would measure 15.6 W. African countries by Morocco and Spain.

The Ministry of Petroleum Resources (MOPR) has approved the construction of a 2,500 km gas pipeline to carry oil and gas from the Niger Delta to the Mediterranean Sea.

The pipeline is to be built by the NNPC and Morocco's Sonatrach and Spain's Repsol.

A report titled 'Worries in Money's revenue restrictions compliance with the Public Information Act (PIA) and further investigation of the PIA to address other issues in the country's revenue sector' was released by the Centre for Transparency Advocacy (CTA) on Wednesday.

The report, which was prepared by the CTI, says that the PIA is a key tool for ensuring transparency in the public sector and that it is essential for the government to ensure that it is fully implemented.

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


